SEPTEMBER HIKES

Sep 2-6 – Breckenridge Trip, 7:00 at NN. Monday, we will hike Cross Creek, south of Minturn, enroute to Breckenridge. This is an easy hike, and will be one of two day-hikes for those of you who aren't going on to Breckenridge. Details on Breckenridge area hikes will be posted on the website.

<u>Sep 4</u> – **Sutey Ranch**, 9:00 at REI or 9:15 at the trailhead. Cindy Ryman will lead stay-at-homes on this Wednesday hike close to home. Mild weather is forecast.

<u>Sep 6</u> – **Pitkin Creek Falls & Lake**, 7:30 at NN. This will be a third, more difficult, hike for those of you not going to Breck. Some of the Breck group also will be doing this hike enroute home. Directions to the TH will be included with other Breck info online.

Sep 9 – Coal Basin, 8:00 at REI. West of Redstone, 4 miles from Hwy 133, the trail climbs 1400' in 6 miles.

Sep 11 – Sweetwater/Rim Lake/Luark/Shingle Peak Loop, 6:30 at NN. From the top of the hill east of Sweetwater Lake, this loop ascends 3100' in 16 miles. Or you may opt for a kinder, gentler option of Sweetwater Creek, from the same TH. This is a 4.5-mile outand-back hike with only 1100' of elevation gain. Meet at NN for an 8:30 departure.

<u>Sep 16</u> – **Crag Crest**, 7:00 at MM. On Grand Mesa, choose between a 7-mile (1000') throughhike, with car shuttle, or a 10-mile (1400') loop hike.

Sep 23 – Skyline Ridge Loop or Snowmass Rim, 8:00 at REI. From Town Park Center (Rodeo) parking lot, we will shuttle hikers to the upper (Divide Road) TH for the Snowmass Rim hike, which ends at Town Park. Skyline Ridge hikers will begin and end their hike at Town Park Center. Should be some fine fall colors on the mountain.

Sep 25 – Keyser Creek to Blue Lake, 8:00 at MM. This steep 5.5-mile out-and-back hike begins above Canyon Creek and ascends 3200' to Blue Lake at 10,400'. Early season snowfall could shorten the hike. Tailgate at the Herbst's home in Canyon Creek Estates.

<u>Sep 30</u> – **Raggeds Trail**, 7:30 at REI. Popular trail near the top of McClure Pass, meanders 4 miles through aspen woodland to a view of the Raggeds Range.

BICYCLING

<u>September 18</u> – **Challenging Ride:** We'll ride beautiful Castle Creek Road to see the changing fall colors. It's about 30 miles round trip with 2,000' of climbing. We'll ride past Ashcroft and Cathedral Lake trailhead to the end of the pavement. Meet at 10:30am at the Aspen Colorado Mountain College parking lot in the Airport Business Center (ABC) west end.

Easy Riders will ride from New Castle to Silt and back. Meet at 9am at Grand River Park on the south side of the river to avoid the construction mess at the new roundabout.

October 2 – Challenging Ride: We'll ride to the iconic Maroon Bells ride to see the fall colors. We'll meet at the Aspen Colorado Mountain College parking lot at 10:30am. Ride is about 25 miles with 1500' of climbing.
