Join us <u>Saturdays</u> for a delightful day of skiing at **Snowmass**. Meet at Ullrhof (on the bench by the restrooms) at 10am or High Alpine Restaurant (upper level) at noon. Drive/carpool or take RFTA. The bus is free to seniors 65+, and a Snowmass express departs 27th Station daily at 7:23. A PM downvalley express departs Snowmass every half hour beginning at 3:15.
