## **2025 OVERNIGHT TRIPS**

Rooms are filling up fast for our three overnight trips. If you fail to make the cut, Gerry will maintain a waitlist for each trip. For those of you fortunate enough to have a reservation, if you need to cancel it, please contact Gerry before you relinquish your room to see if there's anyone on the waitlist to fill your vacancy.

## MOAB, UTAH, MAY 12-16

We have 20 double-queen rooms set aside for us at \$179/night plus 14.92% tax (\$822.23/4 nights) at the <u>Hotel Moab</u> <u>Downtown</u>, 182 S Main Street. Reservations may be made until April 12, after which any unreserved rooms will be released to the general public. You may cancel up to 14 days prior to arrival without penalty; otherwise, you will be charged one night's lodging. To book your room, either call (435) 259-7141 or email <u>info@hotelmoabdowntown.com</u>. Be sure to mention that you're with the **100 Club**. The hotel doesn't open for the season until March 3.

All Rooms have free wi-fi, flat screen TV, coffee maker, microwave and mini-fridge. Other amenities of the hotel include pool and hot tub, as well as a large, adjacent, park-like area suitable for tailgates. There also are several restaurants within walking distance (no mileage credit allowed), including <u>Cactus Jacks</u> next door, open 7:00 am to 2:00 pm, and the <u>Moab Diner</u> (across Main Street/Hwy 191) serving breakfast beginning at 6:00 am (open 'til 9:00 pm). There are other restaurants within easy walking distance for dinner, as well as several coffee shops for lighter breakfast fare.

## **GUNNISON/CRESTED BUTTE, JULY 21-25**

A block of 15 ground-floor double-queen rooms has been reserved for us at the <u>Rodeway Inn</u> in Gunnison for \$131.99/night plus tax (\$612.43/4 nights). <u>Additional rooms may be available by calling (970) 641-0500</u>. Be sure to tell them you're with the **100 Club**. We failed to find anything in Crested Butte at a reasonable cost for our selected dates. Though Gunnison is 27 miles from Crested Butte, saving us almost \$100/room/night seemed worth the additional mileage. Book by June 30 with penalty-free cancellation until July 18. The Rodeway offers a complimentary breakfast buffet, wi-fi, icemaker and hot tub, as well as in-room coffee, microwave, mini-fridge, and flat-screen TV.

If you opt to book different accommodations, including campgrounds, be aware that our tailgates will be held at the Rodeway Inn in Gunnison, and there may not be cell service at your location to notify you of any schedule changes.

## LAKE CITY, SEPTEMBER 22-26

We'll be using two hotels for Lake City. They are physically contiguous, which will facilitate tailgates, BBQs, and general socializing. These are small, but attractive, properties with little flexibility in the rooms they offer. Some have 2 queens, some kings, some have kitchenettes, and some are pet friendly. The various rooms can be previewed on the hotel's respective websites by clicking on the links (blue hypertext) below. Rooms are typical of other hotels we normally book in small-town CO. Our dates are peak leaf-peeping season in Lake City. It's also base camp for no less than five 14ers.

A block of 12 rooms has been reserved for us in the <u>North Face Lodge</u> (970-944-5200), our primary hotel. Our booking agent & co-owner is Mr. Hugh Conway. Use the phone# (not the website) to book your room. Club members who book their rooms in December will receive 2024 pricing (currently \$170-175/night plus tax). Any unreserved rooms will be released June 22. You may cancel without charge up to 3 weeks prior to check-in. Each Room is unique and decorated very attractively.

In addition, seven rooms are reserved for us at the <u>Alpine Moose Lodge</u> (970-944-2415), our secondary hotel. Tracy is our booking agent and owner. Use the phone# (not the website) to book your room. A <u>non-refundable</u> one-night deposit is required at time of reservation. In event of cancellation, your deposit can be applied to a future reservation. Any unreserved rooms will be released March 31.

When booking, please identify yourself as a member of the **100 Club**. In the event all rooms are booked, or if you need more choice, try the <u>Matterhorn Motel</u>. It's roughly one mile from the North Face Lodge. Barbara and Mike Larime stayed there and found it plain, but perfectly comfortable. The owner is very accommodating. Double queen rooms currently are available for \$170/night with one night's non-refundable deposit, similar to the Alpine Moose.
